<p>10 10.1 10.2 10.3 10.4 10.5</p>	<p>CLERKS REPORT ON ACTION FROM MEETINGS</p> <p>Highway issues update, 30mph Old Battersby Tony Lewis to be contacted for an update.</p> <p>Battersby Junction Entrance Road At the entrance there was a large hole on the edge of the road, N.Y.C.C, Highways had filled half in with tarmac and the other half with soil. The Parish Clerk had complained about this as vehicles are driving over the soil. Photos were shown to the Councillors and had been email to Cllr H. Moorhouse. It was agreed that a letter would be send to Cllr H. Moorhouse and N.Y.C.C. Area 2 Thirsk about the poor quality of service and workmanship received from Highways contractor regarding this issue.</p> <p>N.Y.C.C. Highways Repairs Ingleby Greenhow to Gt Broughton Road. Water leak problem on the Broughton Rd Cllr T. Sutcliffe had met with the Highways inspector, who was looking at the other leak (near the cricket field) which was being dug out by Mr Greenwell, Ingleby Estate plumber. They looked at the leak and the Highways Inspector took some photos and would report back to Area 2. Tarmac had recently been put in the hole but it was still standing in water. Mr Greenwell thought it could only be a very small leak if at all and suggested it could be a land drain. Cllr T. Sutcliffe would contact Keith Clark landowner, and Richard Wardman Farmer, again to try and move things forward. The water remains however even in the driest weather, and the road is deteriorating and will again be a problem in winter.</p> <p>Maple Lodge Old Battersby In the past a request had been made to Highways for some of the reflectors to be replaced on the corner, after they had been damage in a road accident. More reflectors in this area were suggested.</p> <p>N.Y.C.C. Battersby to Baysdale (Coleson Bank) Temporary Prohibition of Traffic There seem to be still motor bikes and 4x4 using this track. At both entrance there should be a road closure sign, the one on the top of the moor had been moved.</p>

Details of two motor bike rider had been taken and would be passed on, N.Y.M.N.P.A. and the Police.

It was approved for the clerk to enquire cost for red and white chain to be place over the entrance at Old Battersby. Cllr L. Smith would contact Mr. L. & Mr K Atkinson and other landowners, to see if they had any objected to having chain cross the entrance.

The N.Y.M.N.P.A would like this route to be reopened as a bridleway. The Parish Council supported this.
