**8.5 Ingleby Estate Water pipes Leak**

The Parish Clerk had contacted John Wallis at GSC Grays at Leyburn, requesting a copy of all Ingleby Estate water pipes in the parish. This request had not been granted by them. Northumbrian Water had been out and confirmed that it was not one of their pipes leaking. It was noted that their was now a yellow arrow near the hole in the road, which as been cause by the leak. Cllr H. Moorhouse was asked to contact N.Y.C.C. about this.

A Site meeting had been held with Michael Waste Water Production Team Leader to look at the new design of the new covering. The Parish Council had now received conformation that the new structure would go ahead on 14<sup>th</sup> October.
