5	OPEN FORUM 1.Defibrillator to be placed outside the dairy building at New Sheepfold Farm. Residents of Sheepfold area of the Parish have been awarded a grant from Yorkshire Ambulance Service NHS Trust toward a Defibrillator. The residents will need to contribute a donation of £999 toward the project. 2.Government consultation on the Glover Landscapes Review. This review looks at 'off roading' in the National Parks. A report was received from GLEAM (Green Lanes Environmental Action Group) It was RESOLVED the Parish Chair would respond on the Green Lanes.

The Parish Council RESOLVED to make representation to HDC raising several points and questions.

9	<p>PARISH COUNCILLOR'S REPORT</p> <p>1. Queens Platinum Jubilee 2022 A meeting has been arranged with Parish Groups to discuss action. Parish Clerk has been asked to seek cost of Jubilee memorabilia.</p> <p>2. Parish Community Newsletter (Focus) This is being updated. The Parish Council RESOLVED to donate £100 toward the cost.</p> <p>3. Ingleby Bank The Parish Council has received an enquiry regarding the possibility of a warning sign following a recent incident in icy conditions at Ingleby Bank Highway have said at this time they are unable to provide a sign. A Councillor proposed that the Parish Council should write to NYCC Highway asking them to provide a similar sign 'Avoid Road in Winter Conditions' as at the Westerdale Percy Rigg junction</p> <p>4. Gully Clearing There are several gullies blocked in the Parish which are covered over with grass and soil and if the NYCC team do not have a map of where they are they can be missed. NYCC have the Parish on a once-a-year Rota for cleaning the gullies. It was felt by a Councillor that NYCC should come out in December or twice a year. NYCC Councillor explained that every Parish is on the annual Rota. The NYCC Highway Manager has been out and jetted the drain at the top of Church Bank Ingleby Greenhow, the gully near the Dudley Arms car park, at Falling Water and at Old Battersby. A Councillor felt that the Parish Council should write to the NYCC Highway department to highlight more frequent clearing would be beneficial.</p> <p>5. Bank Foot Road, Ingleby Greenhow. Near the footpath going toward the Manor vehicles have been using the field entrance as a passing place causing damage to the verge. A Councillor suggested a passing place be requested at this location. To be reported to NYCC.</p>
