16	<p>PARISH COUNCIL REPORT</p> <p>ON ACTIONS FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS</p> <p>16.1 Broadband Old Battersby No new update</p> <p>16.2 Street- light provision overnight at Ingleby Greenhow over the defibrillators HDC have agreed not to charge the Parish Council for the reconnection to the light which will be on overnight.</p> <p>16.3 Footpaths Ingleby Greenhow The Chairman has received several complaints about the gates which are across the path. This path has been in continuous use by the public for many years. The Occupier of Mason Cottage has information from the footpath department at NYCC that the path in front of his house is not a public footpath. Resolved the Parish Council would take no action while the path remains open for use.</p> <p>16.4 Ingleby Greenhow ownership of Pound area It is not registered with the Land Registry. In the Parish Council minutes book of 1980 it is in the minutes that the Parish Council purchased a seat to go in the area. Resolved Parish Clerk to submit an application from the Parish Council to claim the area.</p>

16.5	Request for Seat above Bank Foot The Chairman would make an application to the NYMNP A under the village improvement grant. The Parish Council Resolved to give £250 toward the seat.
16.6	Land adjacent each side of the entrance to Brackenburn These two areas of land are not registered with the Land Registry. Resolved the Parish Clerk to make more investigation.
16.7	Work on Stone Stoup trees deferred from 2020. The Contractor G Davies, Gt Broughton quote was £400, this was agreed along with additional work on the PC tree Church Bank.
