Alterations raising of height of dwelling and construction of first floor extensions. Approved with 6 conditions

7 Proposed Path Diversion at Bonnie Hill Farm Gt Broughton Diversion order no 2016/01. Update.

The above order was made on the 27th June 2016. The effect of the Order will be to divert a public footpath running at Bonnie Hill Farm.

N.Y.C.C. Cllr H. Moorhouse gave an update the N.Y.C.C. Public Right of Way Officer, Andy Brown had been out and look at the diversion and his report was now with H.D.C.

8. CLERKS REPORT ON ACTION FROM MEETINGS

8.1 Highway issues update,

Cllr H. Moorhouse had met with M. Robert from N.Y.C.C. Highways to discuss the issues with Lambs Lane. N.Y.C.C. stated it does not have the money to make major repairs to this road in this years budget or next year. School Bank is schedule to be repaired in 2017/18.

The Footpaths in Ingleby Greenhow are also scheduled to have work on them and all residents will receive a letter. There are in place drop kerbs where need to go in, it was agreed that a meeting would be held with N.Y.C.C. Highways to discuss this.

8.2 Old Battersby

Cllr L. Smith informed the Parish Council that the road in the village, has been marked out with white marking, this may have something to do with the recent road survey which had taken place in the Parish for repairs in 2017/18.

8.3 Village Clock, Repair work cost £1200

The Parish Council have received a grant from N.Y.M.N.P.A for 50% (£600) of the repair work, to the village clock. The accepted form was signed and returned to the N.Y.M.N.P.A.. It had been agreed at a previous meeting that the Parish Council would give £300 and the Fawcett Family the other £300.

8.4 Fly Tipping

There seen to be a lots of fly tipping in the Parish. On Church Lane a number of tyres had been left, and at the top of Turkeys Nab a large amount of rubbish. The N.Y.M.N.P.A had been contacted about this rubbish who had said that it was up the H.D.C to remove it. Cllr R. Kirk agreed to speck to H.D.C about the rubbish at the top of Turkey Nab, but it was felt that they would have no vehicle capable of going up Turkey Nab.

8.5 Footpaths in the Update

Atkinson Wood Farm, Ref 10.56/44/1

The first application for a diversion had been rejected and a new one was to be submitted. Mr Yewdell was cleaning out the avenue of trees. Parish Clerk to contact Ingleby Estate on clarification if the farm is still part of the estate..

8.6 Oak Wood to High Farm Easby

Cllr T. Hill gave a report that the replacement sign post is in place but the path up to High Farm is still very difficult to walk.

8.7 Dummerhill Farm Ref 10.56/44/1

The Parish Council had received no new update on the unofficial footpath diversion.

8.8 Bonnie Hill Farm, Maintain bridge Ref CAMs 60482/ 60483

An email had been received to say that this would be investigated from Waste and Countryside, Business Support administrator, but no name on the email. The Parish Council felt that this was incorrect as all correspondence should have a name and contact and telephone number include..

8.9 Footpath from no 33 Battersby Junction to Ingleby Greenhow

The Parish Council had received comments about cows in the field, when anyone walks the footpath and have dogs with them, the cows tend to follow/chase people. The Parish Council felt that people used the footpath at their own risk, and must take care when with dogs.
