Only to raise issues about French doors on the south elevation front of house which are not be in keeping with the adjacent dwelling. Also sandstone to match that on the existing house.

7 ISSUES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING

7.1 Planning Demblin Easby

It was noted that the Enforcement Officer at HDC, is considering appropriate action.

7.2 Verge near Demblin

There were concerns about the mains water pipe which run along the verge. This has been reported to Northumbrian Water..

7.3 Battersby Junction Access Road and Culvert Crossing

Network Rail has written to Zeligrate about the condition of the road. It was noted the top of the entrance road needs to have kerb stones along the edge of the verge to improve the area

7.4 Coleson Bank – NYCC

Motorbike Riders are still using the track, although there is a sign stating the road is closed. The Police are out on some weekend with the NYMNPA Rangers stopping Riders. The Chairman has requested the Highways Police take action and prosecute offenders

7.5 Turkey Nab Road to Farndale – NYCC

Cllr T. Sutcliffe has written to NYCC Highways asking for a survey to be completed on the safety of the road for the public to use. NYCC Highways has agreed to do a survey.

7.6 Atkinson Wood Farm work undertaken without Listed Building consent.

The Parish Council has received no new update from the NYMNPA, on the work which has been done.

Also work done in the avenue of trees. A question was asked about the name plates that were on the tress are they still in place. The Local History Group to be contacted.

7.7 Old Battersby Water Supply

Cllr L. Smith gave an update, the kiosk was now in place, electric to the kiosk now installed. The Residents hope to have safe drinking water by May.

7.8 St Andrew Church

It was noted that the gate post has been knocked and does not look safe. Cllr F. Porter informed the meeting that work was in hand to repair the gate post.
