NYMNPWA are still following up issues on these applications.</p>

This road has now been surface dressed. When NYCC put the road closure signs up which were placed at the junction near to Holly Farm Easby it did not indicate that the road was still open to Ingleby Greenhow and Battersby Junction. The Parish Council agreed to express it's concerns to NYCC.</p> <p>C1 Kildale Village, 30mph limit East of Kildale Junction with C24 Battersby Avenue. This road has now been surface dressed.</p> <p>C24 Green Balk, Great Broughton, Junction with Back Lane to Junction with Lambs Lane. Work on this road should have started on the 10th May, it was delay as the machine was not width enough to cover all the wide of the road. A future closure will take place.</p> <p>C160 Lambs Lane Ingleby Greenhow, Junction with Ingleby road to Junction with B1257 Clay Bank. This road has now been surface dressed.</p>
<p>12</p>	<p>DEFIBRILLATOR</p> <p>Three Defibrillators have been ordered by the Parish Council. The one at Ingleby Greenhow would go next to the lighting column No 4, Battersby Junction no 11, and at Old Battersby no 4, subject to final agreement of HDC with connection to the lighting columns. Three private donations have been received and one more to come in towards the defibrillators and also a grant of £2000 from HDC.</p>

More money was needed and it would not be completed for at least 3 months.</p> <p>High House Farm Greenhow Bottom The defect was reported to NYCC on the 05/02/18 and as been on the work programme since then. There was major work to be done as the culvert has now collapsed, and more money was now needed by NYCC to to do the work.</p> <p>C24 Old Battersby to Junction of Marsh Lane/Lambs Lane This road is in a great need of repair in Ingleby Greenhow. NYCC has now</p>

In Ingleby Greenhow the lights have been renewed. Some of the old lighting columns have not been removed.</p>
