Highways are unable to provide the programme for the whole of Ingeby Greenhow due to it size. The Network Strategy team has advice that the Kaarbontech model is designed to improve long-term efficiencies, and they are only in the second year of the initial 2 year programme and they are confident, on completion they will have visited every gully at least once.

	<p>The programme uses a risk-based approach to determine the most appropriate schedule for each gully using the date they have available. They are aware that this had led to some gullies near each other falling into different cleaning schedules that is less efficient, but such instances are being reviewed to allow them to make improvements prior to the start of next year's programme April 2026.</p> <p>Drain on Stone Stoup were not visible and covered in grass. A drain can appear blocked, but it is still functioning also this is not sufficient to justify additional cleaning if the remaining drains on that system are working as they will capture any residual water.</p>
